

- 1. Pray that your children will know that God is with them. He is their strength! "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go" (Joshua 1:9 NASB).
- 2. Pray that your children will listen to God's voice and follow in His ways. "Your ears will hear a word behind you, "This is the way, walk in it," whenever you turn to the right or to the left" (Isaiah 30:21 NASB).
- 3. Pray that your children will set an example for others in speech, conduct, love, faith, and purity. "Let no one look down on your youthfulness, but rather in speech, conduct, love, faith, and purity, show yourself an example of those who believe" (1 Timothy 4:12 NASB).
- 4. Pray that your children would be diligent and hard-working in their academics and in their study of God's word. "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth" (2 Timothy 2:15 NASB).
- 5. Pray that your children will do justice, love kindness, and walk humbly with the Lord. "He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God" (Micah 6:8 NASB)?
- 6. Pray that your children will do good to all around them, both those within your family and outside of it as well. "So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith" (Galatians 6:10 NASB).
- 7. Pray that your children will not choose to do wrong, but instead will overcome evil with good. "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good" (Romans 12:21 NASB).
- 8. Pray that your children will love God with all their heart, soul, and mind and that they will love others well. "And He said to him, " 'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the great and foremost commandment. The second is like it, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Matthew 22:37-39 NASB).
- 9. Pray that the Lord would complete the work that He is doing in your children and that you would be able to trust His timing. "For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus" (Philippians 1:6 NASB).
- 10. Pray that your children will know, through the power of the Holy Spirit, to know how wide, long, high, and deep is the love of Christ for them. "I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God" (Ephesians 3:16-19).
