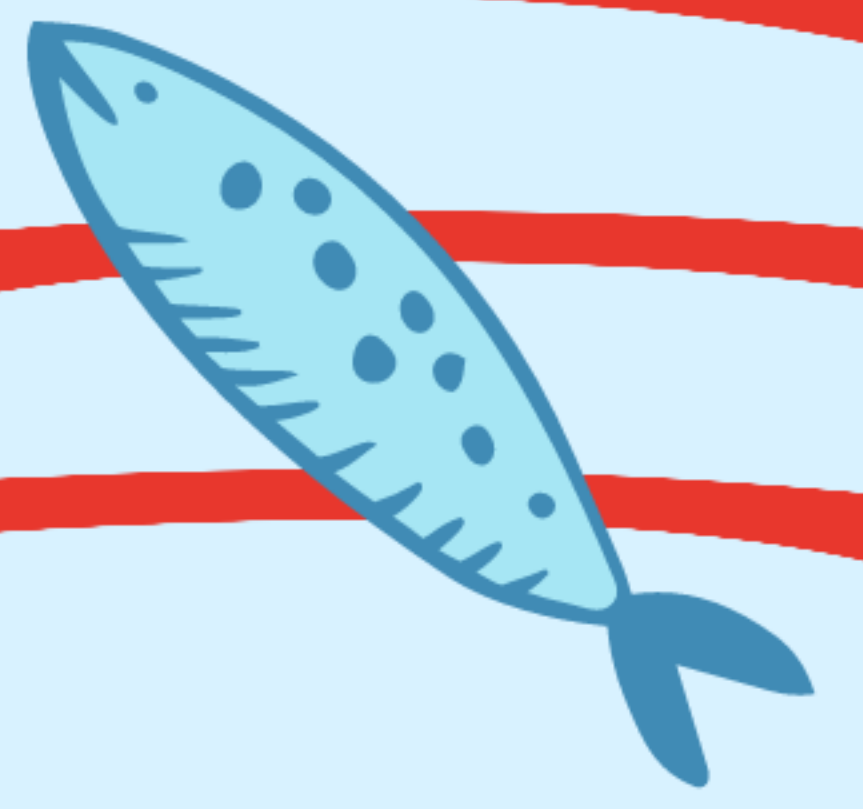
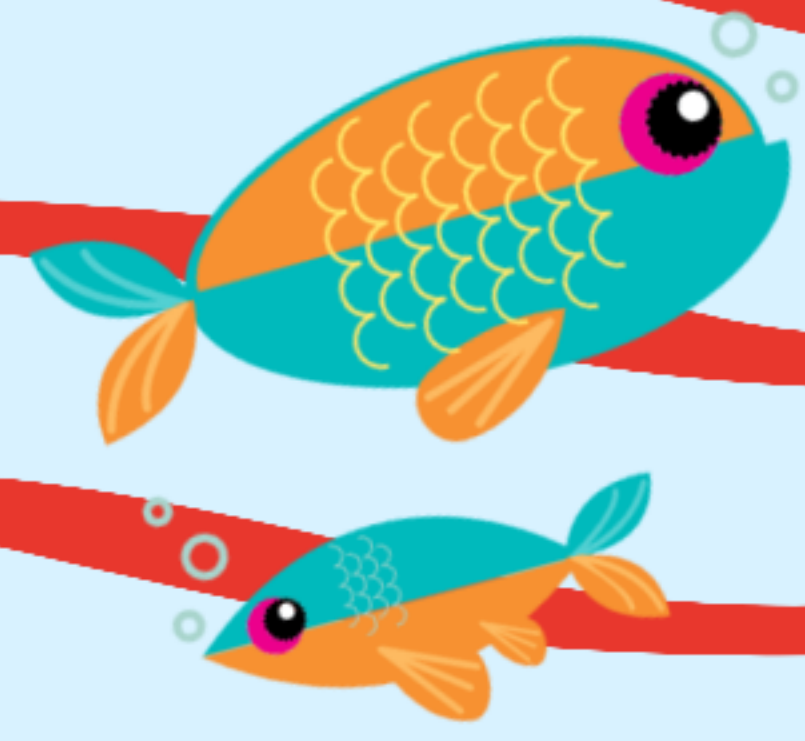


Observing Passover

In remembrance, hang your paper chain over your front door to represent the blood of The Lamb.
