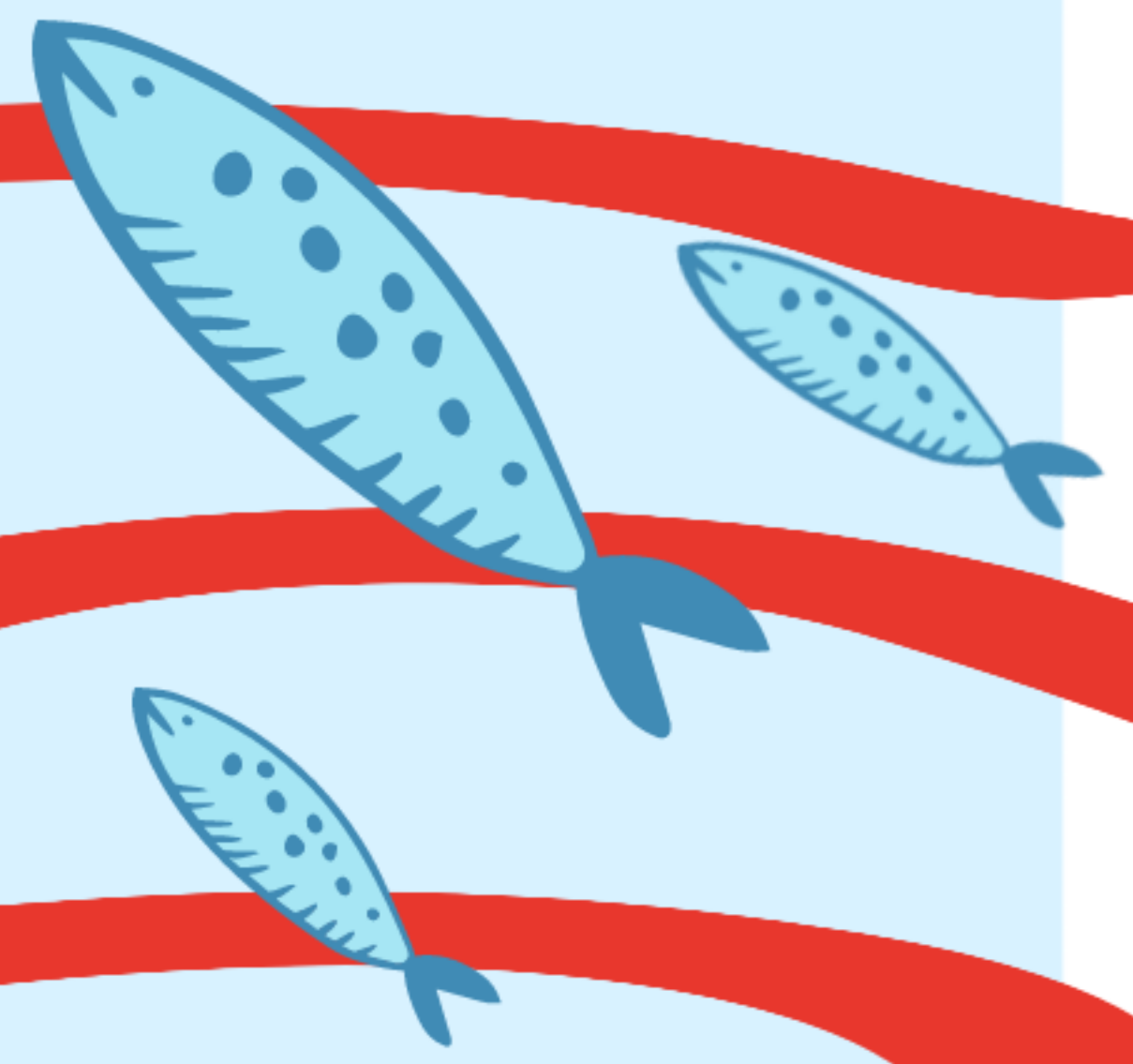


Observing Passover



Decorate a "Red Sea" Themed Table

Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and the Lord drove the sea back by a strong east wind all night and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided. Exodus 14:21

Decorate your table with a Red Sea theme. It will make the Seder dinner memorable but also captivate your children and guests' attention.

Gather up as many Lego and Playmobile figures as you can and recreate the miraculous crossing right down the middle of your table! If you don't have boys in your house, mini dolls and figures can also work. Be creative with construction paper, dollar store plastic tablecovers, sand, sea shells, glitter (whatever your mama creativity can handle).

The most important part of this re-creation is the re-telling! Make sure to read the Passover and Israelites escape from slavery from Egypt in

Exodus 12:1-30 and Exodus 14:1-31.
